SHOOT REPORT

WALWORTH Jan 7th & 8th

The First Shoot of 2023 proved to be a Surprise, Challenging, Highest scoring and Lowest scoring shoot to date with the Highest number of paperwork errors recorded. Shooters, it is your responsibility to check the score sheets before you leave the field, it is also your responsibility to check the Club sheets, is Lewis checked off if played, High Gun Score on sheet correct, Stein & Hayes if appropriate etc. Be Aware, 20% of you who played High Gun and Lewis were never added to the record sheet, one shot a 50, another a 49 and lots of other good scores from BOTH DAYS!

Thus, the following: 1) The Inland Waters Constitution States "the Secretary / Treasurer will run and be paid for the Sunday shoot minimum; it is preferred both days, but the club can hire a past Secretary for Saturday to save money as a volunteer. 2) You are allowed either 3 Make up's or Shoot a head's PER YEAR – PLEASE DO NOT WAIT TILL THE 9TH SHOOT AND REALIZE YOU ARE SHORT SHOOT TO QUALIFY FOR THE BANQUET / TROPHY SHOOT – REMEMBER THE LAST SHOOT (10TH) SHOOT IS MENDON AND THAT'S THE HAMPTON / TROPHY SHOOT WHICH YOUR AVERAGE WILL ALREADY BE CALCULATED AND CLASS ASSIGNED! 3) SHOOTERS, CHECK YOUR SCORES, GOOD, BAD, OR INDIFFERENT BECAUSE ONCE IT'S ON THE REPORT SHEET IT'S FINAL! Now we've discussed the Bad and the Ugly, lets finish off with some good notes. • Walworth put 137 shooters through, plus 10 Juniors, 11 MU's / SA's, and 2 practice rounds • On Sunday Andrew Goodwin, Lima Junior Shooter, posted his first Inland Waters 50 straight and to prove it wasn't just a lucky round he did a SA and posted a 49, one short of a perfect Century CONGRADULATION ANDREW – GREAT JOB!!! Walworth posted more 50's then we've seen to date and 49's and 48's due to good target presentation, No Wind on Sunday, above freezing temps and people with cabin fever looking to get out and shoot. Next shoot is at Victor February 4th & 5th and if any of you have any Holly influence please ask for a nice above freezing, calm weekend which would be Fantastic!!
