Check your email...

We have been warning our customers about the problems with these older email accounts ever since Spectrum took over their accounts. However, it now appears that Spectrum has no intention of resolving problems with these emails moving forward.

Users that are still using older Roadrunner email addresses that look something like this: user@rochester.rr.com should be warned that your email account may be removed or deleted or disabled in the near future.
