


In the upcoming weeks, you will see the following facilities upgrades being performed at the ORGC!

- New trap light poles are being installed. This will include removing the old poles and footings, rough grade, and remove spoils. New footings will be installed, and the poles will be erected. Poles and hardware will also be painted.
- There is a drain project that will include installation of new drains and a concrete pad. Drains will be connected from the back door out to the East side of the property. They are then connected to the drainage ditch. This will prevent flooding in and around the back door to the club.

This year is coming to a close - 2024 will be here in just a few weeks! ORGC dues renewal notices will be sent in early January. As we did this past year, the invoices will be emailed to those members who have emails on file.

Reminders:
