The ORGC is updating our FOB system – Summer 2024!

- The current system was the one originally installed for the ORGC. It can no longer be updated due to age and technology constraints of the old system. The software is no longer supported. If the system were to go down, there would be no access to the club by members.
- New System highlights include:
 - Hardware will be updated and connected to a hosted internet site
 - 0 Software will be installed to manage the new system
 - Hardware has the ability to be expanded to offer more points of entry
 - Same readers and same fobs will be used no change there
 - Data stored on the cloud to prevent loss and remote access
 - Customizable access for events as needed
- Old system and new system will run in parallel until new system is proven out, at which point the old system will be turned off.

No action needed by our members! The transition will be seamless and provide a more robust and reliable FOB system for our members! Thank you to Andy DeBuyser for coordinating this effort to keep the ORGC current with technology!
