ORGC PROPERTY UPDATES

The safety and enjoyment of the ORGC is a top priority! Here are a few of the latest projects that help keep the property in great shape for all to enjoy!

Recently, there was work done to remove trees at the rear of the Eagles range on the property. These trees were within 6' of the foundation and needed to be taken down. Also removed during this project were several dead ash trees and large poplar trees near the barbed wire.

There will be 2 steel light poles installed for the West trap field. These will replace the wood poles that are leaning and deteriorating. Poles are in the process of being purchased and are tentatively scheduled to be installed sometime during the Spring/Summer.

The ORGC will be updating the trash removal contract for the property. This will include an additional tote to ensure that the trash can be removed timely and that during the busy months, trash is not overflowing from the bin and causing an unsightly mess.
