



REMINDERS

Range Security Access is limited to members and their guests.

Your FOB records your IN AND OUT. Close the gate each time you pass. Do not allow anyone else to enter without using their own FOB. There is a fee for lost FOBs.

Please **SIGN IN every guest** in the log located in the box on the long range. Two (2) guests per member at a time, and no more than 3 times per year. Get them to join.

Wear your ID or have it visible to identify yourself as a member. Get to know who is using the facility.

Anyone deliberately destroying or damaging anything on the range, shoot houses, clubhouse or grounds, including wildlife, will be subject to immediate removal and will face the consequences of such actions in accordance with our ORGC Bylaws and Constitution.

Use of equipment provided in Eagles Range is a privilege of membership. It is expected that all people who use the range will leave the range in good condition for the next user.

Put all equipment away.

Remove your targets from the stand and discard.

Pick up your brass.

Put all tools away.

Put your trash in the trash can.

PRACTISCORE is an easy to use online format for registering for sport shooting events and matches. It is free to create an account on Practiscore. Once you register, it becomes a place where you can see your sport shooting history. You can register for matches and events, pay for matches and events, search areas for matches and sport shooting events of interest to you, and pay for the match or event online.

It is quite easy to use.

- Go to www.practiscore.com.
- Click Register in the upper right corner
- If you use Facebook, Twitter, Google or in Linkedin you can use one click registration by clicking o one of the social network icons.
- Or you can register by adding your email address, creating a password, your first and last name.
- Once you are registered, you can login.
 - The Dashboard is the place you will be directed. It contains the many features of Practiscore. Spend a few minutes investigating to discover how activities are happening on Practiscore. It is widely used, in fact, it is just about the only way to register for some events.
- If you click on Matches, you will see an interactive map of matches in the area. You can type in ORGC to see the matches happening at our club. You can touch the map to see matches in other clubs or areas, too.
- If you click on Events, you will see an interactive map of events in the area. You can touch the map to see what event is 'pinned' on the map.
- Under the tabs you will see Upcoming Events. This is YOUR personal list of events you have registered to attend.
- Below your Upcoming Events are your Recent Events. These are events you have already completed. When you click on any event on the list, you will see the Match Results for that event.

It's easy to see why Practiscore is now being used by clubs across the U.S. for all their events and matches. It helps organize and plan for attendance and it makes it easy for people to reserve a place in any events that have a limited participation or a cap on how many participants. For example, our Tuesday Night USPSA Practice Matches fill up rapidly since we can only have 10 people on a squad. Registration opens on Tuesday at 9 p.m. and once the two squads are filled, registration is closed. It helps people plan their shooting competitions and allows ranges to plan for those who will be in attendance.

RANGE RULES REBOOT-CEASE FIRE! Section 3.0

- 3.12 CEASE FIRE means STOP SHOOTING IMMEDIATELY AND AWAIT FUR THER INSTRUCTIONS. A CEASE FIRE may be for an emergency, or to alert oth er shooters to stop shooting. No person shall be allowed forward the firing line with out a CEASE FIRE condition in effect.
- 3.13 A CEASE FIRE MAY BE CALLED BY ANYONE.
- 3.14 **During CEASE FIRE condition:** All shooters are to immediately STOP shooting, actions open, chambers empty and loading devices removed. If a firearm does not lock open (by design) the shooter must place a Chamber Flag in the chamber.
- 3.15 RED LIGHTS must be utilized. After a CEASE FIRE is called, the RED LIGHTS should be switched to the ON position. All shooters manage their firearms as per rule 3.12, and an "ALL CLEAR/RANGE IS COLD" announced and ACKNOWLEDGED BY EVERYONE ON THE FIRING LINE prior to ANYONE moving beyond the firing line. Once everyone has returned to behind the firing line a "EVERYONE READY/RANGE IS GOING HOT" IS ANNOUNCED and ACKNOWLEDGED BY EVERYONE ON THE FIRING LINE and the RED LIGHTS should be switched OFF prior to ANYONE resuming shooting.


