



Who: Whether new shooter or seasoned marksman, Project Appleseed has something for everyone! Participants must be at least 12 years old to handle rifles per NY State law.

Novice Shooters – quickly understand how to handle your rifle safely and effectively.

Experienced Shooters – master the skills needed to hit targets out to 500 yards (the Rifleman's 1/4 mile)

Experts – shoot the Appleseed Qualification Test and earn your Rifleman patch.

What:

Improve your shooting using marksmanship techniques which have been passed down from generation to generation and are taught by experienced Instructors

Learn about the perseverance, personal responsibility and civic virtue that led to the founding of our nation.

Hear the stories of April 19, 1775 – the battles of Lexington & Concord, and America's struggle for independence.

Honor the sacrifices those early Americans made to preserve our liberty and freedoms.

What you'll need: Participants should bring a rimfire rifle with functioning sights or a scope, and attachment points for a sling. 400 rounds of 22LR should be enough ammo for the weekend. Please pack lunch, snacks, and plenty of hydration. A shooting mat or something comfortable to lay on is recommended, along with a folding chair to use during breaks. Eye and ear protection are required on the range.

Tickets: Adults \$75, Youth \$30. Range fee is \$10 per shooter. Covers both days.
