ARE YOU READY?

It seems like everyone you talk to lately is ready; ready to start living as we used to, or as close as we can come to it given the circumstances facing us. Consequently, the Scatter Sheet has a different look for this month. Since the club has essentially been a ghost town for the past few months, there are no pictures, no events happening or scores to report. Our calendar has been a virtual wasteland. Reaching each milestone will allow us more opportunity to return to normal, in the meantime, we have been planning for our present status.

The ORGC Board of Directors recognize the need for members to be allowed to use their memberships and enjoy being outdoors. They consulted with Senator Pam Helming's office and others, and following Executive Order #202.31 under #13—Recreation. *Outdoor, low-risk recreational activities are permitted so long as social distancing and cleaning/disinfection measures are in place. Here are the ORGC guidelines based that decision and NYS PAUSE/Covid-19 orders, which are in place until further notice.

- ORGC, a private club, has been and will remain open to MEMBERS ONLY. No guests shooting or observing.
- Observe the posted official club hours for shooting on Eagles Range or the Rifle Range.
- The clubhouse is closed and will remain closed until we receive direction from NYS.
- The PortAPotty is available.
- Your dues must be current. You are required to FOB in and out.
- Observe COVID-19 requirements for masks and 6' social distancing.
- Clean up your targets, stands, casings, trash. Clean up after use to avoid other having contact with your left items.
- Tuesday Practice Pistol and Open Trap will begin with restrictions listed from the ORGC Plan of Action response to NYS PAUSE/COVID-19 on pages 2 and 3.

Practice Pistol will resume for MEMBERS ONLY adhering to the ORGC Plan of Action specifications in response to NYS PAUSE/COVID-as noted below until further notice..

If you have failed to pay your club dues by April 30, you must renew before you shoot any rounds of trap or participate in practice pistol.

We are counting on members to observe and be cooperative with the guidelines we have established while we begin to bring the club back to life.

- MEMBERS ONLY. No non members or guests allowed at this time. You must be a member of ORGC to participate and we apologize for the restrictions and hope to open to everyone at the start of Phase 2.
- No clubhouse access. The clubhouse is closed. PortAPotty is available.
- Registration will open promptly at 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday night.
- Payment will be done strictly on Practiscore at the time of registration. No walk-ons. No cash payments.
- Squads are strictly limited to 10 shooters. No exceptions allowed.
- Set up will start at 4:30 p.m. Please arrive early to help with the setup.
- Practice will start promptly at 5:30 p.m. Please be ready to start.
- Please observe the 6' apart social distancing.
- Please bring a face mask with you.
- There will be no classifier at this time.

REMINDERS

Range Security Access is limited to members.

Your FOB records your IN AND OUT. Close the gate each time you pass. Do not allow anyone else to enter without using their own FOB. There is a fee for lost FOBs.

Wear your ID or have it visible to identify yourself as a member. Get to know who is using the facility.

Anyone deliberately destroying or damaging anything on the range, shoot houses, clubhouse or grounds, including wildlife, will be subject to immediate removal and will face the consequences of such actions in accordance with our ORGC Bylaws and Constitution.

Put all equipment away.

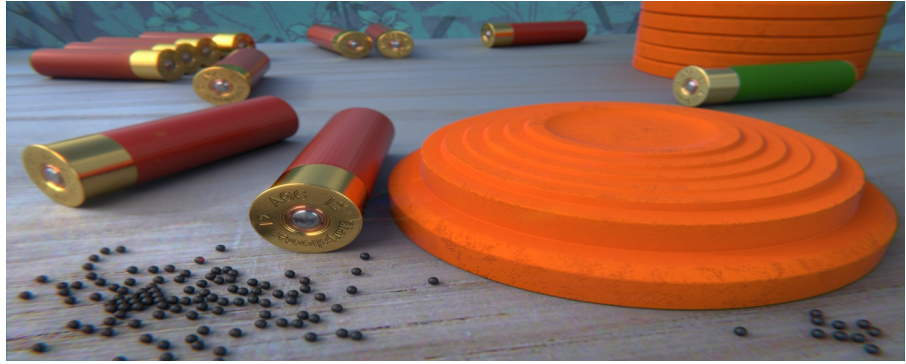
Remove your targets from the stand and discard.

We are counting on members to observe and be cooperative with the guidelines we have established while we begin to bring the club back to life.

Open Trap

- Members only. No Guests shooting or observing.
- No clubhouse access. The clubhouse is closed. PortAPotty is available.
- 5-9 p.m.
- Check in on the trap fields
- Exact amount for payment. Change will not be given. \$4.00 as usual.
- Limit of 2 rounds of trap unless nobody else is waiting to shoot.
- Maximum of 10 people allow at a time
- If you arrive and we have reached 10 people, you can sign up and wait in your car until your turn
- Two trap houses will be used to keep things moving along.
- Masks should be worn while waiting
- Please observe the 6' apart social distancing.
- While shooting, you may remove your mask
- Trap shooters may want to park in the west parking lot.

- Match is rain or shine.

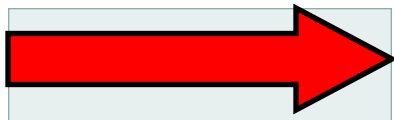

- Other learning opportunities outside the practice will be available.
